

TENIPOSIDE (VM-26)

Type of Drug: Plant Alkaloid

How is it Given?

- Intravenous (IV) – into a vein or central line

How Does it Work?

- Interferes with the growth of cancer cells

Common Side Effects:

- Low blood counts
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Mouth sores

Less Common Side Effects:

- Low blood pressure
- Rash
- Numbness/tingling in hands and feet (nerve irritation)
- Allergic reaction (hives, itching, flushing)
- Abnormal liver function tests
- Abnormal kidney tests

Note:

- Your blood pressure will be monitored throughout the infusion.
